Tuition payment options- Full Year Program:

A) Payable in full on or before July 15th, 2010

B) Payable in two equal instalments on or before July 15th 2010 and December 1st, 2010. (There will be an additional \$1,000 US finance charge due with the July 15th payment)

* A \$5,000 US deposit is due by June 15th, 2010 to reserve a place. This deposit will be credited towards whatever payment plan is selected.

*Students are required to maintain a \$2,000 US initial-balance expense account with the CGJA. Expenses incurred (i.e., tournament expenses, medical charges, golf equipment, etc.) will be paid through this account and a monthly statement of charges and remaining balance will be provided to the parent(s). When the account balance falls below \$500 US, the parent(s) will be notified by the CGJA and will be responsible for replenishing the account.

*Students will compete in events primarily on the Future Collegians World Tour (www.fcwgtgolf.com) and the Florida Junior Tour (www.floridajuniortour.org). Students are responsible for the cost of tournaments, transportation if any, accommodations and meals for themselves and chaperones while attending tournaments.
