The above tuition rates include:

- Golf instruction with PGA Professionals; playing and practice privileges at Orange County National Golf Center; mental performance program; video analysis; nutritional education; fitness membership, assessments & training.
- Residence program includes double occupancy accommodations; house supervisor; daily dinners and groceries provided for breakfast, lunch, and snacks while in residence; wireless internet access, home telephone, and cable television; general house cleaning services; local transportation to golf and group activities.
- College placement assistance is available through our new division, College Golf Connect (pricing separate from above tuition)
- Tuition payment options- Full Year Program:
 - A) Payable in full on or before July 15th, 2011
 - B) Payable in two equal installments on or before July 15th 2011 and December 1st, 2011. (Financing charges will apply to this option)
- A \$5,000 US deposit is due with the submission of the Enrollment Agreement and will be applied to the selected payment plan. Enrollment Agreement will be sent to applicant upon acceptance to the program.
- An additional \$5,000 US deposit is required by July 15th, 2011 as an initial-balance for the student's expense account with the CGA. Expenses incurred such as tournament expenses, golf equipment, airport transportation, and other incidentals will be paid through this account and a statement detailing the expenditures and any required reimbursement will be issued on an as needed basis.
- Students will compete in events primarily on the Future Collegians World Tour (www.fcwtgolf.com) and the Florida Junior Tour (www.floridajuniortour.org). Students who are above the age of 19 can arrange their own schedule on the Moonlight Tour (www.ogatour.org).
- Students are responsible for all tournament expenses including membership dues, entry fees, practice rounds, yardage books, transportation, accommodations, and meals (including on-course food provided) for themselves and chaperones (split between all participants).
- Rates apply to post-graduate students only
- Weekly and monthly programs subject to availability
